**Season and Cancellation, 2011 1<sup>st</sup> practice Tuesday May 03 - Season Ends: June 28<sup>th</sup>**

(age on Dec 31, 2010)

- Players aged 4-9 (U6-U10) practice Tuesday and Thursday, **6:00 - 7:00 p.m.** at the CNC and LDSS Fields.
- Players aged 10-13 (U12-U14) practice Tuesday and Thursday, **7:00 - 8:30 p.m.** at the CNC and LDSS Fields.
- Players aged 14-15 (U16) practice Tuesday and Thursday **4:30 – 6:00 p.m.** at the CNC Field.
- Players aged 16-17 (U18) practice Tuesday and Thursday **4:30 – 6:00 p.m.** at the LDSS Field.
- Other practices, games and tournaments to be announced.
- Practices are cancelled only when lightning is forecast or present or when coaches are not available.
- Coaches will **try** to contact all players as best they can for any schedule changes.
- No refund's after the second week of practice.

**Parental Role**

- Parents are required to stay on the field to supervise their children and are asked to participate whenever possible.
- Burns Lake Youth Soccer Club is not responsible for supervision of children, before, during or after practice or games.
- Your children will need you for questions, for washroom breaks, and to show you their skills – please be there for them.
- We require your help if your child is not able to, or willing to, participate cooperatively.
- Support your child, play with them at home, encourage them to learn the rules and practice their soccer skills.
- Coaches are volunteers, they need your help in organizing the teams, cleaning up after practice, etc. Work with your coach to help the team. Please respect your child's coach.

**Teams**

- U6, U16, U18 are mixed teams, U8-U14 are separate boys and girls teams.

**Water**

- All players must have a bottle of fresh water with them at every practice.

**Player Behavior**

- Players whose behavior in practices or games is unacceptable may be disqualified from practices and games
- Divisional players must show BC Youth Soccer I.D. before all home/away zone games
- All decisions of game referees and coaches must be respected on the field
- Children left unattended before, during or after practice may be disqualified from membership.
- Membership in the Club is subject to the sole discretion of the BLYSC Executive.
